

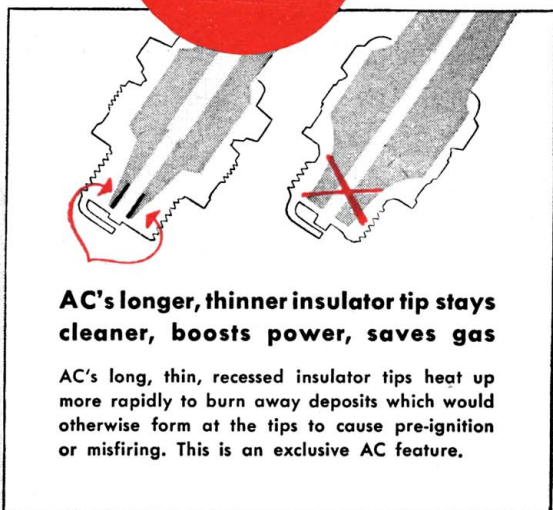


## Sure-fire starting for the Firebird
